



A QUICK CARTMELIAN GUIDE TO SURVIVING NIGHTS OUT IN LANCASTER

- There are free buses that run from campus to clubs and from clubs back to campus at the end of the night. Find out which clubs run them and at what times (Sugarhouse always does) and use them, it's much cheaper than a taxi which on average costs around £10 to main campus.
- If you have to get a taxi ask to be dropped off at the gate at the back of Cartmel South, I've found it to be up to £4 cheaper than the route that takes you all through campus.
- Have the porter's phone number in case of emergency and always be polite to them, after all they are the only people with spare keys if you lose yours.
- It's always best to have change for entry into clubs.
- Keep an eye on your drink at all times, if you have to leave it leave it with a friend who you trust to keep an eye on it and don't minesweep, it's not worth the risk.
- Don't wear your best shoes to Hustle, they will become stuck to the floor and coated in an unknown substance.
- Always take your purple card and ID out (Citizen cards and non-UK driving licences are not accepted forms of ID).
- Know your limits and try not to exceed them, not every drink needs to be alcoholic and you can actually have a pretty good night on fizzy drinks alone – the company should make the night.
- Be warned, the phone reception isn't great in The Sugarhouse but still make sure you let your friends know you're home safe if you've left before/after them.
- Don't cook when drunk! There are plenty of cheap take-aways both on and off campus, although you can't eat on The Sugar Bus or in most taxis.
